PROPOSED SCHEDULE:

Registration 9.30am

Groups start playing 10.00am followed by the Knockout stages

Approximate finish time 5.00pm

Entry Fee is £15.00 per team entered (Maximum of 2 No. teams per league)

Players must report to the Control Station at least 30 minutes prior to the Schedule start time

Each league may enter one or two teams. **Each team to consist of between 2 & 4 players**, from players who have played at least **TWO** times in their local Surrey League in the current season, with the players remaining the same throughout the day.

The venue can accommodate eight teams playing four ties at the same time.

Prizes include Awards plus a mix of other prizes from one or more of our sponsors

The playing format will be 4 Singles and one Doubles. Two points for a match win. Then games difference, points difference between any tied teams. Knockout matches played to a win. In each tie the order of play will be 1v1, 2v2, doubles 1v2 & 2v1. Choice of the two singles players in each tie is for each team to decide. The doubles can be any pairing from the 4 player team maximum.

Free Tea, Coffee and Squash will be provided throughout the day with minimal light bite nibbles at lunchtime. Free Parking is available in the side streets around the venue.

EVENT REGULATIONS (please keep this page for your reference)

- 1. Applications are invited from all of our Surrey affiliated leagues: Croydon, Guildford, Haslemere, Reigate/Redhill, Sutton, Thames Valley & Wandsworth to take part in this seasons Inter-League team Championships. Each league may enter up to 2 No. teams. Surrey TTA are very keen for each and every league to be represented. Eight teams is the maximum for this competition, however if the number of teams needs to be limited, entries will be reduced firstly from leagues fielding 2 No. teams on a last in last first out basis.
- 2. Each team will consist of between 2 & 4 male and/or female players, from players who have played at least twice in the current season, in their local Surrey League. The playing format will be 4 Singles and one Doubles. Two points for a match win. Then games difference, points difference between any tied teams. Knockout matches played to a win. In each tie the order of play will be 1v1, 2v2, doubles, 2v1 & 1v2. The players representing the League in each match is for the team to decide. The doubles can be any pairing from the 4 player maximum.
- 3. Completion and submission of the application form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition. No team will be permitted to play unless the appropriate application form has been fully completed and signed and the entrance fee(s) fully paid in advance.
- 4. Application Form All application forms must be fully completed and received by the event organiser by no later than 8.00pm on Thursday 11th April 2019 and are to be accompanied by the full payment of the fee(s). NB: No prepay = no play.

- 5. All competitors must report to the control table on arrival and at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time. If players are not ready to play when required they may be scratched/removed from the event.
- 6. All matches will be the best of 5 games. Play initially will be on a group basis, followed by knockout rounds
- 7. Competitors must wear rubber soled shoes. Players must not wear shirts that are predominantly white.
- 8. All competitors will be required to umpire.
- 9. Competitors can be any age
- 10. The hall will be available at 9.00am on the 28th for knocking up and practice.
- 11. Competitors may be permitted to practise on tables not in use at the discretion of the Event Organiser.
- 12. Bats and balls will be subject to ITTF rules
- 13. Free Tea, Coffee and squash making facilities will be provided by STTA throughout the day and minimal light bites will be provided at lunchtime. There is also plenty of food & drink available for purchase at local shops beside the venue.
- 14. Free Parking: there is plenty of free parking in the adjacent/nearby roads (avoiding yellow lines). You may be charged if you use Waitrose car park for any length of time
- 15. Changing rooms and a kitchen are available at the venue.
